The **International American Studies Association (IASA)** invites applications for the following positions linked to its refereed journal, the *Review of International American Studies (RIAS)*. Terms of office will range from 2 to 4 years.

Applications are invited for the following posts:

- Editor-in-Chief (4 years)
- Associate Editors (two) (4 years)
- Public Relations Associate
- Book Review Editor (4 years)
- Copy Editors (two years, renewable)
- Editorial Board (eight) (4 years)

Who should apply?

The posts are ideally suited for distinguished American Studies experts / scholars / academicians interested in furthering international scholarly exchange. Some experience in editorial work and in scholarly publishing is necessary.

Job Description: The work involves planning and announcement of journal issues (selection of themes, call for papers, deadlines, etc), screening of articles, editorial decisions, proof-reading, and co-ordination with the team to produce timely issues of the journal. The Editor will have the overall responsibility for RIAS. He / she will be supported by the Associated Editors, PR Associate and the Editorial Board.
